- Pursuant to the Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the SIARGAO DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE 2025 (DSPC) for school paper advisers and student/pupil-writers/delegates in both private and public elementary & secondary schools will be held on January 8-10, 2025 at San Isidro, Surigao del Norte with San Isidro District as host.
- 2. The theme of this year's conference is **Promoting Good Governance**, **Leadership and Transparency** through Campus Journalism.
- 3. The activity aims to:
 - a. promote understanding among campus journalists/participants on the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
 - c. provide learners the opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 4. To avoid class disruption, all training programs in preparation to the DSPC 2025 will be held after class hours either **on site** or **on line**. Also, a comprehensive District/School Based Schools Press Conference accomplishment report including the process, protocols observed, list of participants and winners must be submitted to the division one (1) week after the conduct of the activity.



- 6. A campus journalist can participate in only one (1) event either in individual or group category.
- 7. The *top five (5) winners per medium* shall be recognized and their points will be included in the computation of the overall scores (combined scores of Individual and Group Contests) however, only the **First Place** in each category is qualified to compete in the Regional Schools Press Conference 2025.
- 8. All participants should wear **school uniform** for their identity during the whole duration of the press conference. Further, 30 seconds (30) SONG/YELL should be presented by district during the recognition of participants in the opening ceremony.
- 9. Every delegate shall bring blanket/malong for the said conference and should strictly adhere the 'No PLASTIC policy to the whole duration of the activity as stipulated in the Division Memo 01-019,s 2024.
