- In line with Regional Memorandum No. 936, s. 2025 and in reference to DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2017, Gender-Responsive Basic Education (GRBE) Policy, this Division reiterates the commitment to integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights in all aspect of basic education governance and implementation.
