

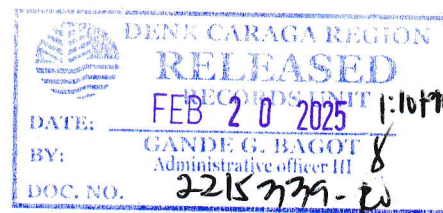

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Youth for Resilience (Y4R) program seeks to develop a new generation of environmental champions equipped with knowledge, skills, and networks needed to advocate for a gender-responsive climate action and resilience within their local communities. As future leaders and key drivers of change, young people play a crucial role in fostering resilience and ensuring sustainable development.

Together with national government agencies, non-government organizations, and youth-led organizations, a training module was co-developed and designed to increase the capacity and inspire the youth to advocate for a resilient future.
