In support of the Schools Division of Siargao's commitment to promoting and protecting the rights of gender-diverse individuals, and in partnership with the Commission on Human Rights Caraga, a lecture on PRIDE and LGBTQ+Rights will be held in celebration of Pride Month on June 11, 2025; 1:00PM 5:00PM at Dapa National High School, Brgy. 6, Dapa, Surigao del Norte.
- 2. This activity aims to raise awareness and foster a more inclusive and respectful environment for learner-leaders regardless of gender identity and expression.





Thirty-eight years ago, the 1987 Philippine Constitution created the Commission on Human Rights (CHR), taking the role as the National Human Rights Institution (NHRI) of the Philippines. The Commission is further entrusted as the country's Gender Ombud under Republic Act No. 9710 or the Magna Carta of Women.

Towards these mandates, the CHR shall ensure the protection and promotion of human rights and recognition of the human dignity of everyone, including persons with diverse sexual orientation, gender identity, and expression (SOGIE).

This June, as we internationally observe Pride Month, the Commission is committed to its continuing efforts in the promotion and protection of the rights of gender diverse individuals. One of our activities for this observance is the conduct of the Lecture on Pride and LGBTQ+ Rights in partnership with different organizations around the region.
