Participants may register and confirm their attendance through the registration link or QR code provided in the attached materials.



MECHANICS

The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme of the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) celebration.

- Registration starts at 7:30 AM while the awarding starts at 11:00 AM. The participant's ID must be presented upon registration.
- Participants will create their posters using a tablet provided by the organizing committee and the free version of Canva.
- Participants are only allowed to use the free features of Canva. AI features, including Magic Studio, is strictly prohibited.
- Participants will be given one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes to complete their digital illustrations.
- The participants will be held accountable for any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

The contest is for the students (Junior and Senior High level) residing within Surigao del Norte.
