SOCIAL MOBILIZATION SUPPORT FOR ST NANDO, STS OPONG, AND
MAGNITUDE 6.9 EARTHQUAKE IN CEBU RELIEF EFFORTS

1. In line with DepEd Memorandum dated September 27, 2025, issued by the Office of the Secretary through the Undersecretary for Governance and Operations, the Schools Division of Siargao is enjoined to extend support and mobilize resources to aid learners and personnel affected by ST Nando, STS Opong, and magnitude 6.9 earthquake in Cebu.
2. Assistance under the *EduKahon Initiative* may include, but is not limited to:
 - a. Food packs and drinking water
 - b. Hygiene kits, first aid kits, and medicines
 - c. School supplies and learning materials
 - d. Temporary learning equipment (e.g., tents, mats, chairs)
3. To ensure efficient logistics and timely delivery, the preferred form of donation is **monetary**, which will enable centralized procurement and faster deployment of relief goods and learning materials to the affected areas. Donations shall be collected per school by the District PDO I and remitted to the Division Cashier's Office **on or before October 7, 2025**.
4. This is to emphasize that this donation drive is **voluntary** in nature.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is directed.

In view of the recent calamities affecting several provinces, unaffected regions are requested to extend assistance, particularly by mobilizing resources under the *EduKahon* initiative, to aid our affected learners and school personnel. For efficiency and proximity, the regions are grouped by quadrant and assigned to provide support to specific provinces, as follows:

- **Masbate** – Regions V (Bicol Region) and VI (Western Visayas)
- **Romblon** – Regions IV-A (CALABARZON) and Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)
- **Cagayan** – Regions I (Ilocos Region) and II (Cagayan Valley)
- **Bulacan** – NCR and Region III (Central Luzon)

Assistance under *EduKahon* may include, but is not limited to:

- Food packs and drinking water
- Hygiene kits, first aid kits, and medicines
- School supplies and learning materials
- Temporary learning equipment (e.g., tents, mats, chairs)

Please coordinate closely with the affected regions to ensure that relief efforts respond to actual needs and avoid duplication. Kindly document all assistance extended and submit updates to the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Service (DRRMS) for consolidation.

Other Regions may also mobilize *EduKahon* relief efforts in coordination with the External Partnerships Service (EPS).
