**TRAINING ON CIRCULAR ECONOMY PRINCIPLES AND CONCEPTS
FOR THE ACADEME**

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Caraga through its Provincial Science and Technology Office (PSTO)-Surigao del Norte, is currently implementing a project titled, " *Generating Resilient, Ecological, and Efficient Waste Valorization through Community -Driven Circular Economy Innovation and Technology (Green Wave)*." This initiative is aligned with the Science, Technology and Innovation for Circular Economy (STI4CE) Framework which promotes sustainability through resource efficiency, innovation and climate-resilient development. The project aims to strengthen the adoption of circular economy models across Siargao Islands by integrating the principles of 10Rs strategies (Reuse, Rethink, Reduce, Refuse, Repair, Refurbish, Remanufacture, Repurpose, Recycle and Recover). In line to this, DOST is inviting teachers from DepEd Siargao to attend a training on *Circular Economy* to be held on October 23-24, 2025 at Del Carmen, Surigao del Norte.
2. The objective of this activity is to raise awareness about circular economy principles and concepts and equips academics with the knowledge to integrate these practices into their curriculum.

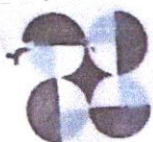

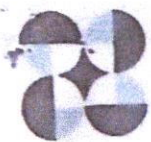
