1. CONTEST GUIDELINES

YELL CONTEST	
Participants	All teaching and non-teaching personnel of each delegation are required to participate in the Yell Contest.
Performance Duration	Each delegation shall be given a maximum of two (2) minutes to perform. Timing will start at the first audible sound or visible movement.
Performance Components	The presentation must include yells, chants, rhythmic claps, or movements that promote energy, unity, and team spirit.
Prohibited Content	The use of offensive, political, vulgar, or discriminatory words, gestures, or expressions is strictly prohibited. Violations may result in disqualification or point deductions.
Props and Instruments	Teams may use safe props or instruments (e.g., drums, flags, pompoms) that do not obstruct the performance area or cause distraction.
Prohibited Props	The use of backdrops, flammable materials, sharp objects, and live animals as props are strictly prohibited.
Choreography and Formations	Groups may incorporate simple movements or formations to strengthen their yell presentation as long as they remain safe and manageable.

Participants	Each delegation may consist of minimum of 50 and maximum of 100 members composed of teaching and non-teaching personnel.
Performance Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The presentation should reflect the theme of unity, teamwork, and celebration in line with the spirit of Education Fest 2025. • Each delegation shall be given a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 8 minutes to perform. Timing starts at the first audible sound or visible movement. • The choreography must feature synchronized movements and highlight the group's coordination, creativity, and overall stage presence. • Musical accompaniment must be clean, wholesome, and appropriate for a DepEd event. Any vulgar, offensive, or inappropriate material is strictly prohibited. • Wearable and non-wearable props are allowed, provided they are safe and manageable. However, backdrops, flammable materials, and live animals are strictly prohibited. • All groups must submit their MP3 music file to the Contest Committee one day before the competition. Late submissions may affect participation.

Performance Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The dance must be based on Philippine folk traditions (rural, tribal, or regional dances). Performance duration should be 3 to 5 minutes only. Recorded music or live accompaniment is allowed. Props and costumes must complement the chosen folk dance and should be safe for indoor performance. Dangerous stunts, fire, or sharp props are strictly prohibited. Performers must maintain decency and cultural respect throughout the presentation.

Performance Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each group will perform one (1) song of their choice — inspirational, OPM, or any meaningful piece suitable for the occasion. Performance time: 3 to 5 minutes. Minus-one (backing track) may be used; no lead vocals allowed in the track. Attire should be modest and performance-appropriate. Lip-syncing or pre-recorded singing is not allowed.
