COLLECTION OF REPORTED LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION CONCERNS FOR S.Y 2024-2025

- All public and private schools are directed to collect and submit Learners Rights and Protection Concerns for S.Y 2024-2025 on or before December 15, 2025.
- 2. This directive aims to ensure the timely consolidation of accurate data on incidents involving child abuse, violence, exploitation, neglect, bullying, Children-at-Risk (CAR), and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL) for appropriate monitoring, reporting, intervention.
- Data to be collected: number of Incidents of Child Abuse, Violence, 3. Exploitation, and Neglect; Bullying Cases; Children-at-risk (CAR), and Children in conflict with the law (CICL).
- 4. Documents to be collected: School-based Consolidation Data Sheet; Incident/Narrative Reports; Intervention Plan; Intake Sheets; and other documents showing referral to partner agencies.
