**DIVISION DEADLINE AND PROCESS FOR THE NATIONAL UPLOADING AND  
VALIDATION OF WASH IN SCHOOLS (WINS) PROGRAM FOR SY 2025–2026  
(ENHANCED-ONLINE MONITORING SYSTEM / EOMS)**

1. In pursuant to the BLSS Advisory dated January 21, 2026 regarding the opening of the National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for SY 2025–2026, this Office hereby issues the Division-level timeline and guidance to ensure timely review, validation, and submission of WinS data through the Enhanced-Online Monitoring System (EOMS).
2. While the national deadline is March 31, 2026, the Schools Division Office of Siargao sets March 20, 2026 (Friday) as the Division deadline for the Division Technical Working Group (TWG) to finalize, validate, and lock all school submissions in EOMS.
3. This internal deadline is intended to provide sufficient time for quality checking, correction of entries, and Division consolidation prior to national uploading.
5. Wide and immediate dissemination of this memorandum is highly recommended.

This Office officially announces the opening of the **National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for SY 2025-2026**. The uploading will commence on **January 26, 2026** and continue until **March 31, 2026** in reference to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 or the "Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program which established quality standards for water, sanitation, deworming and health education. The Three-Star Approach (TSA) is used by the WinS Program as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition and quality assurance guided by DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.

Please be advised of the following:

1. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the latest version which includes the SBFP indicator requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex.
2. In the event of a discrepancy between the result of the offline monitoring form and the uploaded monitoring at the e-OMS, the result on the uploaded report in the e-OMS shall be the official star rating. The star rating indicated on the uploaded form shall prevail.
3. For non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools, please upload a blank form only.
4. In the event of an uploading interruption, the issue will be coordinated directly with ICTS-SID. In case the ICTS-SID advises that system maintenance is required, Regional WinS Coordinators will be notified accordingly.

To be guided properly, all ROs and SDOs WinS Coordinators are highly encouraged to revisit DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 and DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.
